WHO IS KEVIN CARR?

Kevin Carr was the seventh president of Newman Theological College, from 1993-2001. He was the first layperson appointed to this position and during his tenure he was involved in a major restructuring and renewal of the College. Committed to a life of service, his accomplishments include an extensive record of contributions to religious and professional organizations and to the broader community in a variety of roles. Even in retirement, he continues to forge a legacy of generous Christian Witness.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE AWARD?

Since 2004, the Kevin Carr Christian Leadership Award has recognized and honoured individuals whose outstanding Christian Leadership reflects the values of Newman Theological College and the qualities that Kevin Carr cherished and exhibited in his work as President.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE AWARD?

Any lay person(s) who has provided significant leadership in fostering/promoting Christian culture, and whose leadership efforts have had a positive and lasting impact in Western and Northern Canada. Nominees who display these qualities beyond their current position of employment will take precedence.

Nominations are invited from individuals, businesses, organizations, and community groups.

This should contain details of the nominee's significant contributions in the areas of leadership and Christian service merit which demonstrates his or her meriting this award. Please refer to the selection criteria for guidance.
