## JULY BULLETIN

My dear friends and parishioners,

Prayerful greetings! This month of July is dedicated as the month for the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. In every Mass the priest officiating the Holy Mass took the Chalice filled with wine and a drop of water and consecrated it to be the real Blood of Christ whom he shed for the remission of our sins. With His Precious Blood shed on the Cross, we are all redeemed. He paid our eternal debt as the Lamb of sacrifice for the atonement of our sins. All bloody sacrifices in the Temple have ended. No blood of any animals can surpass with the price of the Blood of Christ that paved the way to eternal salvation. Blessed be His Most Precious Blood! What a selfless and humble offering that paid the price of our salvation.

The theme of humility is central to our readings this month of July. God Himself is a humble God, so if we wish to follow Him as Christian stewards, we too, must be humble. In fact, humility is key to the stewardship way of life, and to a peaceful and fulfilling life.

In our Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus Himself speaks to the Father of the privileged role that humble souls play in God's plan of salvation. What does it mean to be a "little one"? It means that we acknowledge we don't have it all figured out, but that we are very much in need of a savior. It means we recognize that all we are and all we have been given is a gift from God. It means we embrace the stewardship way of life.

It is not easy, but deep peace and consolation come with this way of life. Jesus offers these warm and encouraging words to entice us to embrace it. "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

Let us resolve to follow in the footsteps of our Savior, embracing the humble path of stewardship. It is the path that leads to peace here and now and ultimately leads us to heaven. As we receive the Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament let His Precious Blood run also in our veins, that we have the conviction to follow Him through our witness to the faith, through stewardship way of life and as missionary disciples. May the Lord who shed His blood on the Cross for us, preserve us from the contagion of corona virus and all dreaded diseases. Let the Most Precious Blood of Jesus cover us for our protection and vaccinate us. Amen
